Cllr R. Yarsley was hosting a meeting to address activities for youths on 19th Oct at The Town Hall at 7pm. She updated councillors on matters that she was dealing with in her role as East Lindsey Parish Councillor.

Cllr Bradwell confirmed that work on pot holes in the Market Place will be undertaken and consultation on parking was to be undertaken with a view to imposing restrictions along Silver Street around school drop off and collection times. Consultations would also be undertaken at the junction of Bardney Road and Mill View Road as parking along Bardney Road was creating safety concerns. The 30 mph speed limit was to be extended to take into account the new housing estate along Horncastle Road.

East Lindsey District Council had provided keys to two establishments in the Market Place who would lock the toilets up at 8.30-9 pm each evening enabling them to remain open longer. Should anti social behaviour or vandalism occur then the later opening hours will be suspended.

The Clerk advised that the Parish Council could not erect signage or any form of enforcement as they didn't own the land in question or had any powers to do so. It was suggested that the residents themselves erect signage or contact was made with LCC who owned the land in question.
